## Tell A Farmer About This!

The **Burnett Inland Economic Development Organisation** (BIEDO) has secured \$74,000 from the State Government to co-ordinate trades training across the Inland Burnett.

The main focus at this stage is on **steel fabrication** (boiler making, welding, fitting and turning etc). However BIEDO will try to assist anyone interested in other areas.

**Different training options are available suited to different levels of maturity, experience & skill.**

Mature-age people (e.g. farmers who do this now, but without a ticket) with some experience and skill are welcome. They may have the option to have their existing skills and experience recognized rather than having to do a complete training course from scratch. Women are also welcome.

Study support is available for anyone who may also want literacy, numeracy or study assistance. All these services are confidential. BIEDO may also be able to arrange carers, or assist if childcare or aged parent care is an issue.
